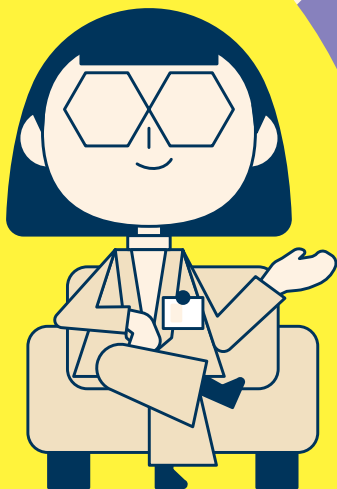

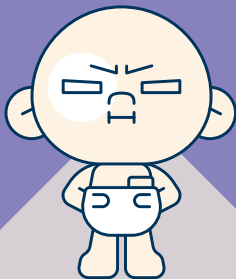

- Red sticker — item should be used by adults only

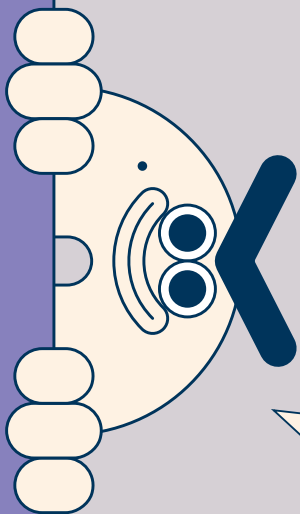

Notes and ideas

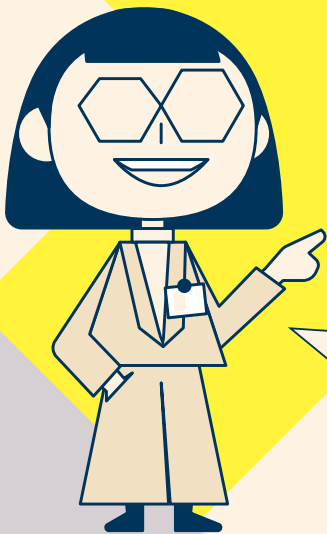
Actually, there's a **theory** about party planning. Parties should have **themes**. After the theme comes the location, the date, and the time. Then you add a handful of guests, a dash of costumes, a teaspoonful of decorations, and mix it all up with some **serious music**. That's the theory. Now — on with the practice!



Theory is called theory because it's just a theory. Who needs guests at a **family party**? Who needs music at a silent party? Who needs water guns at a **cleaning party**? And who needs a costume if it's a "be yourself" party? What we're saying is, your party — **your rules**.

Call it a trash party!

This is a cleaning-up party, and it's fun. Why? Because we do it to music. We're super-cleaning heroes, and we have super-cleaning powers. Who's the fastest trash collector? Who's the strongest trash carrier? Who's actually a trash detective, finding stuff in super-secret places? By the way, the snacks and drinks are rewards for completing the party tasks.



This party can be an ongoing thing in your house. Set up a scoreboard, and award points to those who complete tasks. There's a big prize at the end — it's another party, of course!

I don't know if you've noticed, but everything around here is a **party**. And if it doesn't look like a party — just put a party **hat** on it. If you don't feel like partying by this point, that might be a problem. You should probably go see ... the rest of this **playbook**! It's full of fun stuff.

A sleepover party!

Well, this is an **easy one**. The time and location are clear. The guests? Invite your friends, and their kids too. Set up some **relaxing activities** like movies or board games. Or maybe a video game battle? Anyways, when everyone finally gets to sleep, they'll be anticipating the **next party** — in the morning. Call it a breakfast party!



It's going to be **crazy**, we know. But don't be a Nosferatu — be a Yesferatu! Any combination is **good**. For example, if your combination looks something like "vampires, Rick and Morty, milkshake, blue, fishing, ponies" — you can do oh **so much** with that!

Let's start by wearing blue!

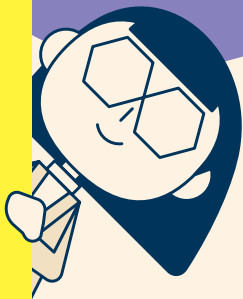
Add some garlic bread to make sure no vampires **show up** at the party. Then

Let's do it!

Have you found the inflatable **die** already? It looks like a cube — it's pretty obvious. Can it become a party? Yes, it **definitely** can. Take a look at this.



But wait — using a die is too **mainstream**. How about switching channels on the **TV** and combining the first things you hear into a party? Or reading the **headlines** of that weird science website you heard about ...

Company matters

You know, most great parties are about the **people** who are there. So you can have one right now with the people you **love**. Turn on the **radio**, and make a party out of disagreeing with the presenter.



If it glows, it's invited to the party!

In the box you'll find lots of **glowing stuff**. It's pretty much all you need for a party. Just set it up, **turn on** some party music, and you're **ready**!

One man's trash is another man's decoration

Everything is a potential decoration. Just use the item to suggest a theme. Old pizza boxes? Yes, now you have a pizza-making party. After all, you've had enough takeout food this month! Or go even further, and use them as canvases. One box = one painting! And then have an exhibition of the paintings, with invited guests, in your own home gallery! Did you know that art exhibitions always start with an opening party?

Mystery item

Sometimes a party is great, but you can't quite put your finger on the exact reason why. Good thing you can put your finger on this mysterious item, which might be just what you need to make your next party a success.
